Free foreclosure prevention event set

At the events, volunteer attorneys, City of Chicago staff, NHS staff and other **HUD-certified counseling** agencies will review homeowners' paperwork to determine if they qualify for assistance under the "Homeowner Affordability and Stability Plan" - known as "Making Home Affordable" (makinghomeaffordable.gov). If so, a loan modification application will be prepared and submitted to the servicer that day via the Internet.
